### **Objective:**

To continue actively serving the Pike Place Market community by serving on the Pike Place Market Historical Commission. Preserve the primary function of the market, to have producers sell locally grown agricultural products. Preserve the unique, historical character of the market while allowing physical changes to ensure a safe, customer friendly environment.

### **Unique Qualifications**

Own a residential unit and have lived within the Pike Place Market Historic District for 26 years. Also own a commercial/office unit in the PPM Historic District.

Appointed by Mayors Rice, Schell and Nickels to the Pike Place Market Preservation and Development Authority (PDA). Served 12 years. Term ended October 2007.

Served on numerous PDA standing Committees including: Executive, Property Management, Finance, Marketing, Farm, and Operations and Communications. Knowledge of PDA charter, history, challenges and politics within the market

Served as PDA Vice-Chair, Chair of Marketing, and Chair of Operations and Communication. Also served as vice chair of several committees.

Participated as PDA councilmember in key activities requiring knowledge and consideration of PDA's charter and Pike Place Market Historical Guidelines including: Capital Renovation Planning, Strategic Plan development, PC-1 Planning, Hildt Agreement amendment and proposed changes of ownership and use.
