The Historic Seattle PDA is an organization created in 1975 in accordance with SMC 3.110. The PDA Council has twelve members, four of whom are appointed by the Seattle Mayor, four of whom are appointed by existing PDA Council members, and four of whom are appointed by the PDA's constituency. All appointments to the PDA Council are confirmed by the Seattle City Council.

Ms. Doyle is a Policy Analyst and Project Director who has been a member of the Historic Seattle Council since 2010 and served as Council Secretary from January of 2011 to May of 2012. Her skills in organizational development and analysis have been invaluable as Historic Seattle evaluates its progress towards the goals of the strategic plan. Her insights as the organization launches a capital campaign for restoration of Washington Hall have been most helpful. As a young native American Ms. Doyle contributes to the governance diversity that Historic Seattle strives for. We look forward to her continued participation in the governance of the organization.

Ms Doyle was reappointed by the Historic Seattle Council at their regular meeting of 5/17/12. Her term will last until 11/30/15.
