- Research Coordinator for Dr. Joanne Stekler's two grants that focus on comparative research methods for early detection of infectious diseases. The two current studies focus on detection of acute HIV infection. Responsibilities include coordination and oversight of multiple off-site locations where the studies are implemented; recruitment, enrollment, and screening of study participants at the Harborview STD Clinic; logistic management of study protocol and supply maintenance; training and oversight of staff at off-site venues who implement the study; and HIV testing, counseling, and linkage to care.

- Disease Intervention Specialist, where my responsibilities included working with populations at high risk for HIV/STIs in commercial sex venues and community outreach settings. This involved me in interviewing clients with skills obtained through Motivational Interviewing trainings, testing high-risk clients for HIV/STIs through rapid tests, blood draws, and specimen collection, as well as providing test results and counseling clients on how to reduce risk, manage diagnoses, and providing information on relevant topics.
