

Played an active role in the structuring of the interview process that resulting in the hiring of the current Executive Director.</p> <p>Mr. Burger is currently the Chairman of the Pike Place Market PDA Market Programs Committee. Mr. Burger's other roles at the PDA included Chairman of the Strategic Planning Committee, member of the Capital Renovation Committee, and member of the Executive Committee. He is a member of the FareStart Board of Directors and worked to help FareStart expand nationally – initially as a separate organization called Kitchens with Missions, now part of FareStart.</p> <p>Mr. Burger's business experience includes being the Founder/President of International Dining Adventures that operated international tours focusing on cuisine and its integral role in culture, Program Manager at Microsoft for Microsoft Mail and Applications Integration, and AT&amp;T as a Systems Engineer.</p> <p>This will be his third term on the Pike Place Market PDA Board.</p>
