<p>Background:</p> <p>The Advisory Committee on Tolling and Traffic Management (ACTT) is comprised of fifteen members, five appointed by the City Council, five by the Mayor and five by WSDOT. In September 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution 31323 appointing its 5 members and confirming the Mayor and WSDOT's appointments. The resolution also establishes the City Council's intention to convene the ACTT.</p> <p>The Council is appointing Brendan Donckers to take the place of Charley Royer, one of Council's original five appointees to the ACTT, per resolution 31323.</p> <p>Brendan Donckers lives in Pioneer Square and works as an attorney with the law firm of Breskin Johnson & Townsend. He serves on the board of the King County Chapter of the Washington Conservation Voters, the Historic South Downtown Community Preservation & Development Authority, is the Compliance Officer for the Washington State Chapter of the Sierra Club, and volunteers regularly with the Northwest Justice Project and the KCBA's Housing Justice Project. He received his J.D. with honors from Seattle University School of Law, an undergraduate degree from Santa Clara University and grew up in South Seattle.</p>
