

Membership must include two (2) licensed architects, one (1) professional fine artist, and one (1) lay member; and, at least one (1) and no more than two (2) from each of the following categories, for maximum total of five (5); professional urban planner, professional environmental or urban designer, landscape architect and licensed professional engineer.
