***Notice of Public Comment related to Resolution 31484:**

As part of this meeting, the Seattle City Council intends to vote on Resolution No. 31484, a "Resolution Supporting Washington State Initiative 522 (I- 522) and expressing the support of the Seattle City Council for the mandatory labeling of genetically engineered products so consumers can make informed choices."

The ballot title of I-522 reads "Initiative Measure No. 522 concerns labeling of genetically-engineered foods.

This measure would require most raw agricultural commodities, processed foods, and seeds and seed stocks, if produced using genetic engineering, as defined, to be labeled as genetically engineered when offered for retail sale.
