Project Name	Sector	Type	Fund Request	Brief Project Description:
Broadway Hill Park	Central East	Development	\$750,000	Transform the empty lot (acquired by Parks in 2010) at Federal Ave. E. and E. Republican St. into an inviting, vibrant park, and community garden space.
Installing Playground at Washington Park Playfield	Central East	Development	\$365,000	Install a full playground at Washington Park Playfield, include play structures for young and older children, seating for all ages and other elements of a play.

Northwest Native Canoe Center	Central West	Development	\$750,000	The Carving Shed will provide insight into distinctive varieties of Native American culture and be a place where Native carvers are safe and the public is welcome. The Shed will include a living roof and the beach will have a carved Welcome Figure.
Completing Magnolia Manor Park	Central West	Development	\$402,500	Opportunity Fund monies will complete the plan for opening up and improving the level area of the park. This project will also provide a needed second access to the P-Patch.

Sacajawea Playground Renovation	Northeast	Development	\$292,000	Renovation to the school district property's playground such as trails, a wetland and play structures to compliment the passive park amenities.
Lake City Skatespot	Northeast	Development	\$750,000	The Lake City Skatespot project is working to add a small skateboard park (skatespot), relocate the basketball court, and add other amenities and improvements at Virgil Flaim Park.

Baker Park Expansion	Northwest	Acquisition	\$500,000	Expand Baker Park by purchasing the property south of the east end of the park. Demolition of existing house and minor site restoration is included in the estimate.
Threading the Needle Park (24th Ave. NW)	Northwest	Development	\$750,000	Improve the 24th Ave. NW street end with a pedestrian greenway, restored waterfront beach, and upgraded dock. Storm water gardens, cisterns, and bio-retention swales are all proposed elements of the project.
The Seattle Sensory Garden	Northwest	Development	\$750,000	Develop touch and smell gardens accessible to people with visual limitations and to those using wheelchairs and other mobility aides. Also include interesting and interactive features for those with autism. The SSG is an expansion of the Woodland Park Zoo Rose Garden on 1.3 acres of existing Zoo property.

Lewis Park Natural Area Improvements	Southeast	Development	\$700,000	A goal is to foster long term community stewardship of the Lewis Park Natural Area and build a trail improvement.
Othello Park Improvements Project	Southeast	Development	\$547,000	Improvements to basketball courts, installation of benches and game tables, prep for P-Patches, rain gardens and bio-swales to address drainage, way-finding markers embedded in walking paths, and expansion of the playground.

South Park Plaza	Southwest	Acquisition	\$669,000	The acquisition presents a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for the South Park community to secure land for future public use that will be; a gateway to the business district, community gathering space, park amenity and connection to the Duwamish River.
48 <sup>th</sup> Ave SW & SW Charleston	Southwest	Acquisition	\$400,000	Acquisition of open green space for use by neighbors and community in nearby urban village; for recreation, physical exercise, gardening, orchards, walking, etc.
Highland Park Playground Improvements	Southwest	Development	\$374,500	Improve access into the park and play equipment that adds to the diversity of play experiences in the neighborhood. Attention to pedestrian flow will tie its new pieces together into a cohesive whole, create a better connection to the neighborhood, make the park more usable and safe for everyone,
