

<p>Background:</p> <p><i>Mr. Luoma is a registered Landscape Architect who practices in Seattle, working on projects throughout the Pacific Northwest. His site design and project management experience has been primarily within the public sector, including enhancements to one Seattle Landmark, Kinnear Park in Queen Anne. Mr. Luoma holds a Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture, as well as a Certificate in Historic Preservation Studies. While a graduate student, he was a teaching assistant for the Bayer's Earthworks Studio, and continued on as a research assistant and contributing author of "Mill Creek Canyon Earthworks: A Cultural Landscape Assessment". The Earthworks in Kent, Washington is a modern masterpiece of landscape art and ecological design, recognized as a designated King County Landmark.
