David Freiboth Bio

David Freiboth is the Executive Secretary Treasurer of the King County Central Labor Council in Seattle and is a Vice President of the Washington State Labor Council, AFL-CIO. Freiboth currently serves on the governing boards of United Way of King County, Workforce Development Council of Seattle - King County, Economic Development Council of King County (enterpriseSeattle), Seattle's Convention and Visitors Bureau (advisory member), the Committee to End Homelessness - King County, Puget Sound Labor Agency and is a Visiting Committee member of the Harry Bridges Center for Labor Studies at the University of Washington. Prior to his 2006 election as Executive at the King County central labor council, Freiboth was the National President of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Marine Division, International Longshore and Warehouse Union. By trade Freiboth is an Able Seaman in the U.S Merchant Marine who, prior to service with his union, worked as a deckhand on the Washington State Ferries. A Kitsap County native, Freiboth is a third generation Washingtonian who graduated from Poulsbo's North Kitsap High School. After graduation he attended Olympic College and Central Washington University studying history. Freiboth completed his BA in Labor History at the National Labor College in Silver Spring, Maryland.
