

John Schoettler – Director, Global Real Estate and Facilities, Amazon.com

Since joining Amazon in January 2001, John has led the team responsible for Amazon's global corporate real estate portfolio. Disciplines within his areas of responsibility include office leasing, asset management and construction management. Design and construction projects include both urban infill and interior improvements of office complexes throughout a global portfolio of over 10MM sqft spanning 150+ locations in 29 countries. In 2006, John's team worked with Vulcan Real Estate to develop a 1.7MM sqft urban campus in Seattle's South Lake Union neighborhood. In 2012, John and the same team negotiated and executed Purchase and Sale agreements for \$1.4BB of real estate investments in both South Lake Union as well as three city blocks in Seattle's Denny Triangle neighborhood. Further, in early 2014 the purchase of an additional city block in Denny Triangle neighborhood will mean 4.1MM sqft will be designed and constructed between 2012 and 2018. John also provides management oversight of Amazon's Global Business Assurance (Corporate Security and Business Continuity and Disaster Preparedness), Global Travel and Global AV Media Services. A Seattle native who is passionate about his community, John currently serves on the boards of the Greater Seattle Chamber of Commerce and the Downtown Seattle Association, and has served on the boards of PONCHO, BOMA, NW Industries and the Seattle Architectural Foundation.

John graduated from Washington State University with degrees in Business Administration and Hotel and Restaurant Administration with an emphasis in Business Economics.
