Seward Park CSO Grants



- **SPU will be constructing a Combined Sewer Overflow facility in Seward Park with minimal above ground features
(authorized by Ord. 124491, June 2014)**
- **Past park improvements in Seward Park have been paid for with grant money from Urban Park And Recreation Recovery Program (UPPAR) administered by the National Park Service**



Seward Park CSO Grants



- UPARR grant conditions limit the park for recreational uses; the limited above ground features of the CSO facility do not comply with the grant
- To remain consistent with the grant, the proposed legislation transfers the grant conditions to park property along Lake Washington Blvd.
- SPU will transfer \$40,000 to Parks to improve the Lake Washington Blvd. property
