


Night Owl service summary

- Provides late-night service between about 2 AM and 4 AM
- Serves a variety of trip types
- Coverage to close-in neighborhoods
- Has operated since at least 1919 in some form
- Gradually reduced through the late 1970s
- Some additions in late 1990s and 2000s

Night Owl coverage

- 6 total Seattle routes
- 3 proposed to be cut in September
- Affects Capitol Hill, Madison Park, University District, Greenlake, Queen Anne, and Downtown
- Savings of about \$550,000 per calendar year
