

### **Current transitional encampments in Seattle**

For the time period from December 16, 2014 to January 21, 2015, HSD reports the following about the four authorized encampments in Seattle:

1. **United We Stand** hosted by Haller Lake United Methodist Church (HLUMC) on HLUMC property at 13055 1st Avenue NE
  - 23 campers: 21 adults, 2 children
  - HLUMC has given an extension to stay through end of February 2015
  - Seattle support
    - Dollars: \$1,354.56/month for two portable toilets (5x week waste removal) and \$203.15/month for one large trash dumpster (1x week pickup)
    - Services: Portable toilets, dumpster.
    - Coordination: None

2. **The Ave Foundation** hosted by University Congregational United Church of Christ (UCUCC) on UCUCC property at 4515 16th Avenue NE
  - 20 campers: 18 adults, 2 children. The family with children has turned down services from Kids Plus\*.
  - From 10/29/2014 to 1/29/2015. No relocation plans have been shared with UCUCC for the move deadline of January 29, 2015.
