COUNCIL BILL 118677

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$26,104,012.91 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4002651984 – 4002655088 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E- Payables of \$159,042.26 on Summit 9000024067 – 9000024150 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$45,347,119.66 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

Section 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

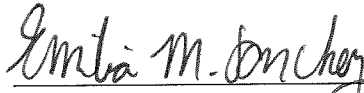

On May 12, 2016, the City Clerk presented to the Mayor legislation passed by the Full Council on May 9, 2016 (Council Bill 118677). On May 17, 2016, the Mayor returned the legislation unsigned, and on May 27, 2016, the Mayor filed a letter stating his reason for not signing the Bill.

Pursuant to the City Charter, Art. IV, Section 12, and Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.B, if legislation is returned unsigned to the City Clerk within ten days after receipt, the legislation shall take effect and be in force 30 days after returned by the Mayor.

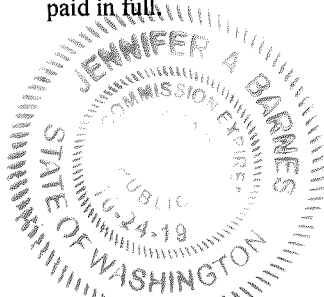
