COUNCIL BILL 119295

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$26,438,775.64 on PeopleSoft 9.2 mechanical warrants numbered 4100063124- 4100065491 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E- Payables of \$96,445.47 on PeopleSoft 9.2 9100000952 - 9100001000 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$24,542,870.93 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

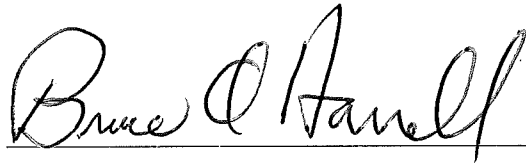
Section 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125493, which amended the 2018 Budget (Ordinance 125475), including the 2018-2023 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; adding new projects; revising project allocations for certain projects in the 2018-2023 CIP; creating both exempt and non-exempt positions; modifying positions; making cash transfers between various City funds; amending a Budget Summary Level purpose statement; revising project descriptions; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment, commonly referred to as the First Quarter 2018 Employment Ordinance; designating positions as exempt from Civil Service status; authorizing the Mayor to execute a Memorandum of Understanding by and between The City of Seattle, Seattle Public Utilities and the United Association of Journeyman and Apprentices of the Plumbing & Pipe Fitting Industry Local 32; creating non-exempt positions; modifying positions; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 2/3 vote of the City Council.
