ORDINANCE NO. 82425

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the annexation to the city of the area between 1st Avenue Northeast and Puget Sound and the City Limits and East 145th Street.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Remington's Revised Statutes Section 8896 et seq, R. C. W. Sec. 35.13.010 et seq, residents of the area between 1st Avenue Northeast and Puget Sound and the City Limits and East 145th Street duly filed with the County Commissioners of King County a petition for annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Seattle; and

WHEREAS, as shown by the duly certified abstract of votes and Resolution No. 14284 of the Board of King County Commissioners (Comptroller's File No. 222397) an election was duly held in said territory on the 15th day of September, 1953, at which a majority of the votes cast were for annexation and the King County Canvassing Board has so found and certified; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16451, adopted October 26, 1953, the City Council has declared that it is expedient that such territory be annexed; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described contiguous territory,

to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present city limits at the intersection of the center line of North and East 125th Street and the center line of 1st Avenue Northeast; thence following present city limits, south on 1st Avenue Northeast to East 90th Street; thence west to the intersection of North 90th Street and Fremont Avenue; thence south to North 85th Street; thence west to 24th Avenue Northwest; thence north to a line midway between West 91st Street and West 92nd Street; thence west to the production north of the east line of 26th Avenue Northwest as platted between West 85th Street and West 88th Street; thence south to West 85th Street; thence west to the west line of Golden Avenue; thence northerly to "V" Street; thence northwesterly to the easterly line of the Great Northern Railway Company right of way; thence southerly to section line on the center line of West 85th Street produced; thence west to the westerly line of the Great Northern Railway Company right of way; thence northerly to the center line of West 95th Street; thence westerly to the middle of Puget Sound; thence, leaving the present city limits, northerly along the center line of Puget Sound to an intersection with the north line of Section 24, Township 26 North, Range 3 East, W.M., produced west; thence east along said section line and the center line of North 145th Street on the north line of Sections 19 and 20, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M., to an intersection with the center line of 1st Avenue Northeast; thence south on said center line of 1st Avenue Northeast to the point of beginning at the intersection of North and East 125th Street.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Seattle as of the

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

4th day of January, 1954 and from and after said date shall become and be a part of the City of Seattle subject to all the laws and ordinances thereof then and thereafter in force.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Remington's Revised Statutes, Section 8886 et seq., R. C. W. Sec. 35.13.010 et seq., residents of the area between 1st Avenue Northeast and Puget Sound and the City Limits and East 145th Street duly filed with the County Commissioners of King County a petition for annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Seattle; and

WHEREAS, as shown by the duly certified abstract of votes and Resolution No. 14284 of the Board of King County Commissioners (Comptroller's File No. 222397) an election was duly held in said territory on the 15th day of September, 1953, at which a majority of the votes cast were for annexation and the King County Canvassing Board has so found and certified; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16461, adopted October 24, 1963, the City Council has declared that it is expedient that such territory be annexed; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described contiguous territory, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present city limits at the intersection of the center line of North and East 125th Street and the center line of 1st Avenue Northeast; thence following present city limits, south on 1st Avenue Northeast to East 80th Street; thence west to the intersection of North 80th Street and Fremont Avenue; thence south to North 85th Street; thence west to 24th Avenue Northwest; thence north to a line midway between West 91st Street and West 92nd Street; thence west to the production north of the east line of 24th Avenue Northwest as platted between West 85th Street and West 83rd Street; thence south to West 85th Street; thence south to the west line of Golden Avenue; thence northerly to "Y" Street; thence northwesterly to the easterly line of the Great Northern Railway Company right of way; thence southerly to section line on the center line of West 85th Street produced; thence west to the westerly line of the Great Northern Railway Company right of way; thence northerly to the center line of West 95th Street; thence westerly to the middle of Puget Sound; thence, leaving the present city limits, northerly along the center line of Puget Sound to an intersection with the north line of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 3 East, W. M., produced west; thence east along said section line and the center line of North 145th Street on the north line of Sections 19 and 20, Township 28 North, Range 4 East, W. M., to an intersection with the center line of 1st Avenue Northeast; thence south on said center line of 1st Avenue Northeast to the point of beginning at the intersection of North and East 125th Street.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Seattle as of the 4th day of January, 1954, and from and after said date shall become and be a part of the City of Seattle subject to all the laws and ordinances thereof then and thereafter in force.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

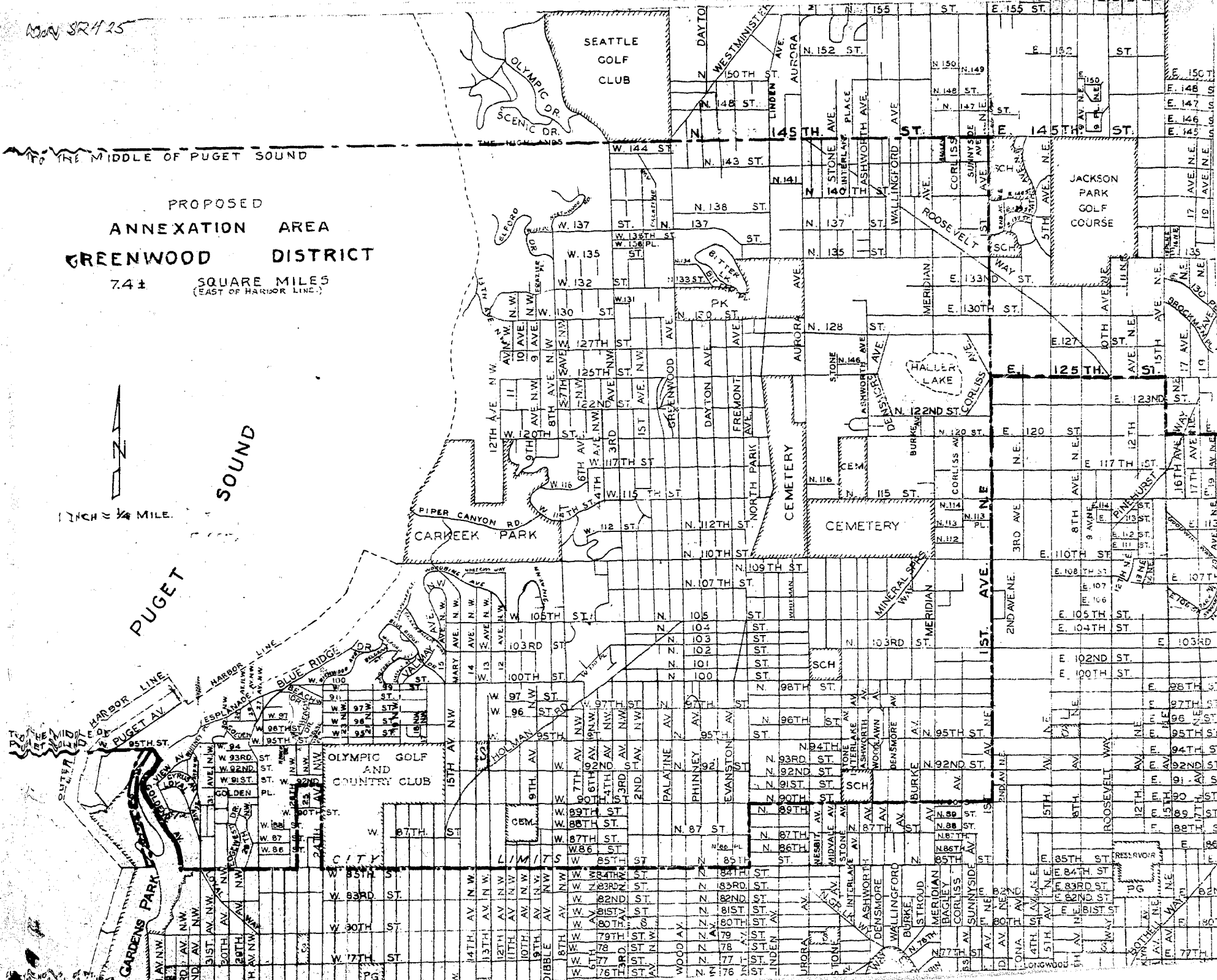

(EAST OF HARBOR LINE.)

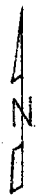
