WHEREAS, between December 2009 and February 2015, a number of Council Bills, Resolutions, and Clerk Files were introduced and were never acted upon by the City Council; and

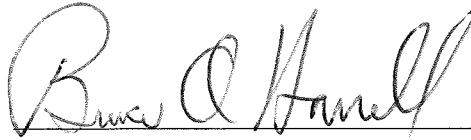

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT:

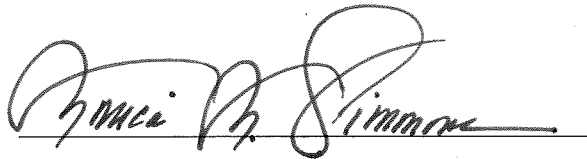

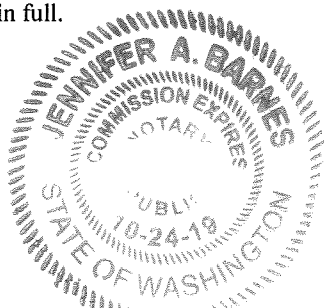
