RESOLUTION 31888

A RESOLUTION amending Resolution 31857 providing conceptual approval of a Significant Structure Term Permit to Seattle Arena Company, LLC to include the construction of permanent tensioned tie-backs in portions of Thomas Street, east of 1st Avenue North and west of 2nd Avenue North, and the long-term occupation of these permanent tensioned tie-backs in the right-of-way to enable the renovation of KeyArena at the Seattle Center.

WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council passed Resolution 31857 granting conceptual approval of a Significant Structure Term Permit to Seattle Arena Company, LLC to construct, maintain, and operate a tunnel under and across Thomas Street, east of 1st Avenue North and west of Warren Avenue North; and

WHEREAS, Seattle Arena Company, LLC has revised the construction plans related to KeyArena renovation to include permanent tensioned tie-backs appurtenant to and necessary for the functioning of the arena at Seattle Center that will remain in portions of Thomas Street; and

WHEREAS, the Director of SDOT ("Director") reviewed Seattle Arena Company, LLC's revised submitted plans and application materials for constructing the permanent tensioned tie-backs and the vehicle access tunnel, considered the factors listed in SMC 15.65.040.C., and all relevant environmental documents and recommends that the Seattle City Council grant conceptual approval of the amended term permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the factors listed in SMC 15.65.040.C and the revised recommendation of the Director;

NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THE
MAYOR CONCURRING, THAT:**

1 Section 1. The City Council finds that the proposed tunnel that would occupy area under
2 Thomas Street and the permanent tensioned tie-backs that would occupy areas below-grade in
3 Thomas Street (east of 1st Avenue North and west of 2nd Avenue North), as proposed by Seattle
4 Arena Company, LLC and shown in the attached Exhibit A, is in the public interest and that no
5 reasonable alternative exists.

6 Section 2. As conditions for obtaining final approval of a Significant Structure Term
7 Permit to construct the tunnel and permanent tensioned tie-backs, Seattle Arena Company, LLC
8 shall:

9 (1) Provide engineering and plans for additional review and permitting to SDOT, which
10 the Director will circulate for review and comment to other City departments and to public and
11 private utilities that may be affected by the installation of the tunnel and the permanent tensioned
12 tie-backs;

13 (2) Provide a surety bond, indemnification agreement, and public liability insurance
14 naming the City as an additional insured or self-insurance, all of which are subject to approval by
15 the City's Risk Manager;

16 (3) Pay all City permit fees;

17 (4) Obtain all necessary permits;

18 (5) Maintain and inspect the tunnel and permanent tensioned tie-backs; and

19 (6) Upon expiration of the permit remove the tunnel and tie-backs and restore the right-
20 of-way to as good condition for public use as existed prior to constructing the tunnel and
21 permanent tensioned tie-backs and in at least as good condition in all respects as the abutting
22 portions of the public place, as required by SDOT right-of-way restoration standards or as

1 specified by the Director or by the City Council pursuant to the provisions of the final term
2 permit ordinance.

3 Section 3. After this resolution is adopted, SDOT shall draft an ordinance that grants final
4 approval of the term permit and describes the proposed conditions of approval. The Council may
5 approve, amend, or decline to adopt the ordinance.

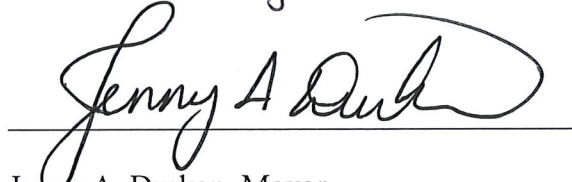
6 Section 4. As recommended by the Director and the Mayor, conceptual approval of a
7 term permit for constructing the tunnel under Thomas Street and permanent tensioned tie-backs
8 in portions of Thomas Street, both being east of 1st Avenue and west of 2nd Avenue North, is
9 GRANTED.

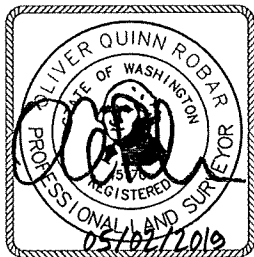
TIE-BACK LEGAL DESCRIPTION

THAT PORTION OF THOMAS STREET LYING BETWEEN 1ST AVENUE NORTH AND 2ND AVENUE NORTH, IN THE CITY OF SEATTLE, IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF PARCEL KK OF CITY OF SEATTLE LOT BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT NO. 3032466-LU, RECORDED UNDER RECORDING NO. 20181011900001 AND CORRECTED UNDER RECORDING NO. 20181030900005, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON;
THENCE SOUTH 88°33'11" EAST, ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THOMAS STREET, A DISTANCE OF 74.75 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 88°33'11" EAST, ALONG SAID NORTH LINE, A DISTANCE OF 509.50 FEET;
THENCE SOUTH 01°26'49" WEST, DEPARTING SAID NORTH LINE, A DISTANCE OF 60.00 FEET;
THENCE NORTH 88°33'11" WEST, PARALLEL WITH SAID NORTH LINE, A DISTANCE OF 509.50 FEET;
THENCE NORTH 01°26'49" EAST A DISTANCE OF 60.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

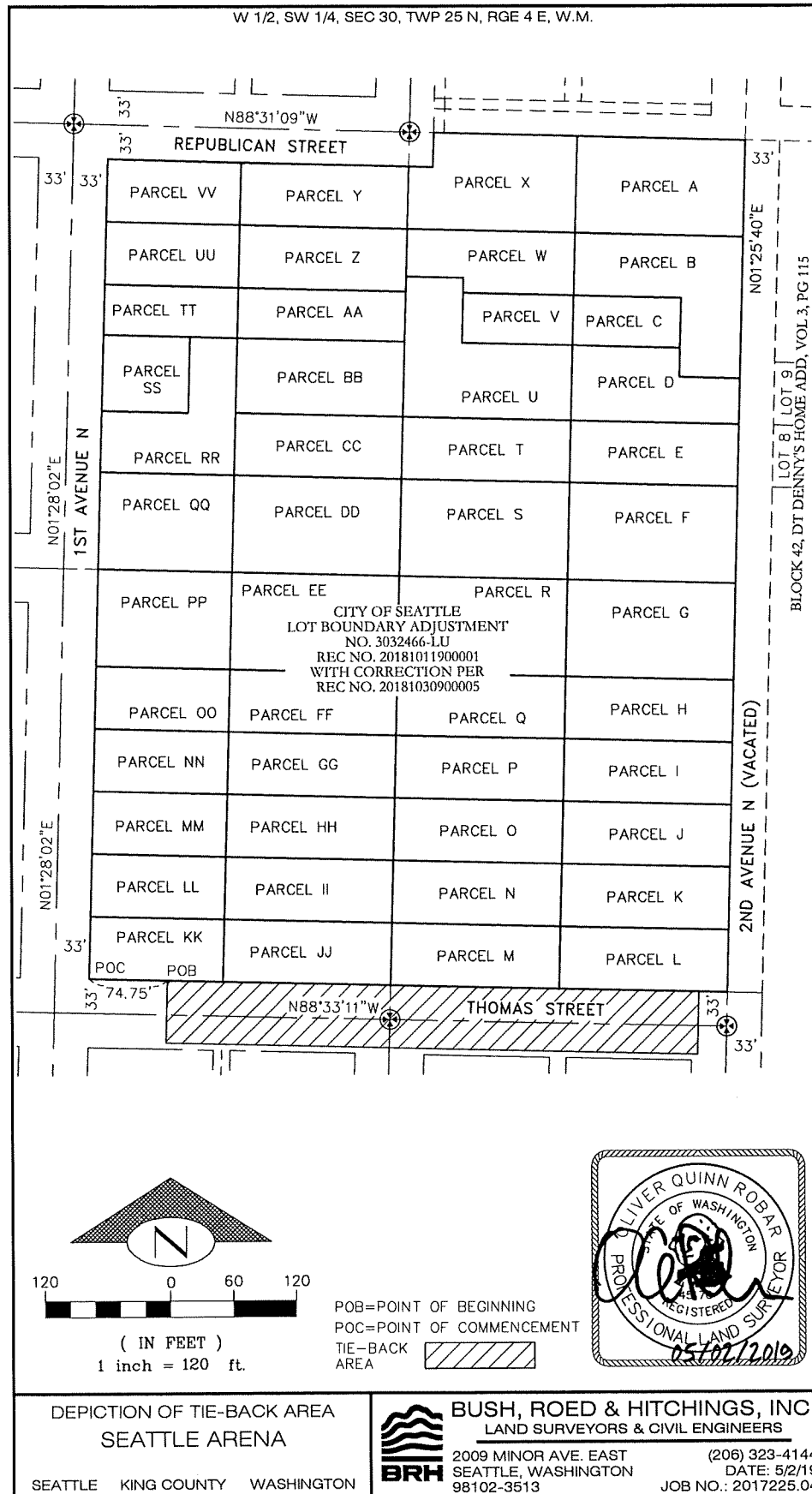
